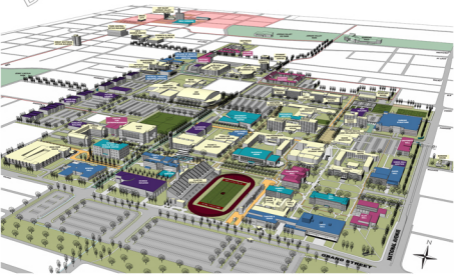

FACILITY MODIFICATION PLAN (FMP) PHASE 1
