Update for Week Ending September 19, 2025

Addition & Renovation, Blunt Hall

Mechanical and electrical commissioning is complete except for two items which will be completed in the next week. Final furnishings installation to be completed in early October. Furniture installation for the Graduate Student Office is complete. Interior building signage and monument signage final installation are pending. Replanting is complete. For the existing building renovation, Level 2 & 3 South are substantially complete except for office ceilings and corridors. Mechanical & electrical work continues on Level 2 North and Level 1. Air handling units start-up and commissioning has commenced. Wall patching and painting have commenced on Level 2 North and Level 1. Phase 2B (Levels 2 & 4 North and Level 1) are scheduled to be completed in December.

Third Floor Buildout, Jordan Valley Innovation Center

This project is substantially complete.

Steel detailing continues. Crane mechanical issues have stopped large steel erection for the last week. The crane company is working on repairs. Shoring has been installed for erecting the steel cantilever. Craig Hall addition concrete wall formwork continues. Craig Hall underslab mechanical, electrical, and plumbing roughin continues. Electrical rough-in continues in the second-floor acting studio and costume storage area. Excavation continues within Craig Hall for the new ADA ramp on the north side of Coger Theatre.

Phase II Renovation, Kampeter Health Sciences Hall

The exterior windows are being installed. Electrical/conduit work is complete. Work is in progress with the lighting fixtures. Ceiling dry fall is complete. Painting is progressing on the first floor. The cable trays are installed. The fourth-floor walls are being painted. The drop ceiling is being installed. Store fronts have been installed. The floor is being prepared for carpeting in the coming weeks.

Replace Skylights, Plaster Student Union

All skylights have been installed, and the demoed material will be removed. The additional roof work will be completed this week.

Clifton M. Smart III Advancement Center

Major steel erection is complete. Steel detailing/decking continues. The exterior event center wall framing has commenced. Interior concrete block wall installation continues.

Lighting Improvements, Plaster Stadium

Minor adjustments to the egress fixtures are scheduled to be completed over fall break.

Replace Roof and Tuckpointing, Suvilla Tower

The Contractor has installed the swing stage and has begun the resealing of the window on the west and south side.

Infrastructure Support for Broadcasting, Plaster Stadium

Lot 4 is now open for parking. Underground electric infrastructure is in place on Carrington Drive. Modifications to broadcast wiring are in process. Punch list items are being corrected.

Renovation, Cheek Hall

The first-floor saw-cutting and concrete removal at the plumbing trenches is complete. The fan coil unit condensate rough-in will begin next week. Vertical stud framing is also underway at Level 1. Drywall installation has begun at the Mezzanine Level and overhead and in-wall mechanical, electrical, and plumbing rough-in continues at the Mezzanine Level. The basement selective demolition for the new electrical room has been completed.
